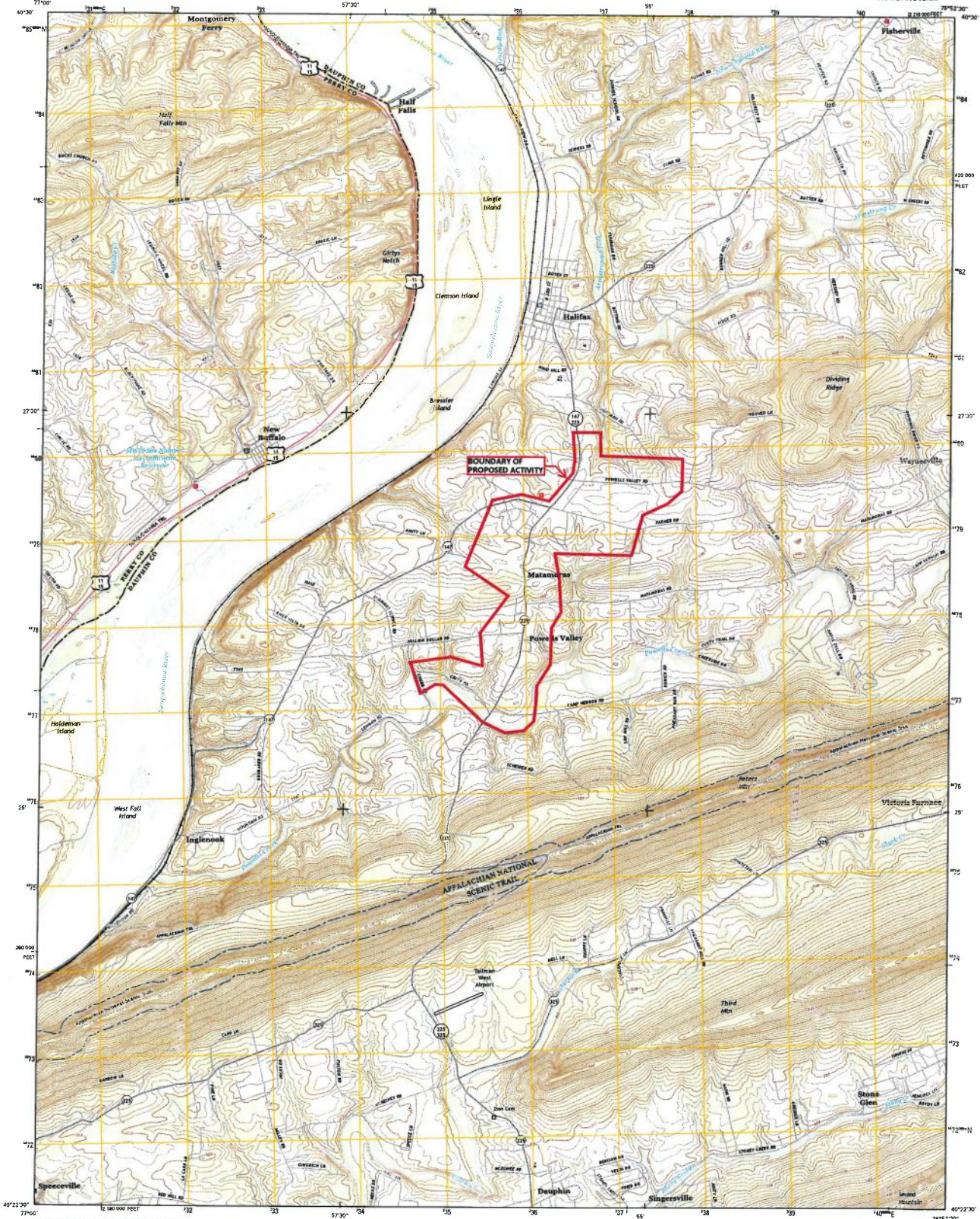
Project Narrative

Halifax Township is currently preparing an Act 537 Plan for the entire Township. There are three focus areas in the Township. The first focus area generally consists of the Matamoras, Route 147 & 225, and Triangle & Lenker Estates areas located within the Township. The second and third focus areas are the areas surrounding the community of Tourist Park and surrounding the Fetterhoff Church, both located within the Township.

At this time, the only sewer extension proposed to be included in the 0-5 year planning period for the Township will serve the Matamoras, Route 147 & 225, and Triangle & Lenker Estates areas. The proposed sewer extension is indicated on the attached map. Sewer like construction work in this area will likely involve the installation of a combination of gravity sewer main, low-pressure sewer main, pumping station and individual grinder pump units at select residences. The sewer installation will connect to the existing Halifax Area Water and Sewer Authority's collection system near the intersection of Routes 147 and 225 in Halifax Township.

The PNDI search indicated the project may have a potential impact upon natural resources within your jurisdiction. Attached are the USGS and National Wetland Inventory maps with the approximate boundary of proposed activity identified. In addition, an exhibit with the proposed sewer extension has been included. With the exception of proposed pump stations, all new facilities will be constructed below grade, mostly within Township and PennDOT rights-of-way.

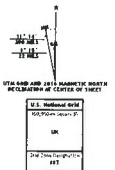
The total area studied is the entire Halifax Township which comprises approximately 20,339 acres. The disturbance from the potential Matamoras sewer extension would be approximately five (5) acres.

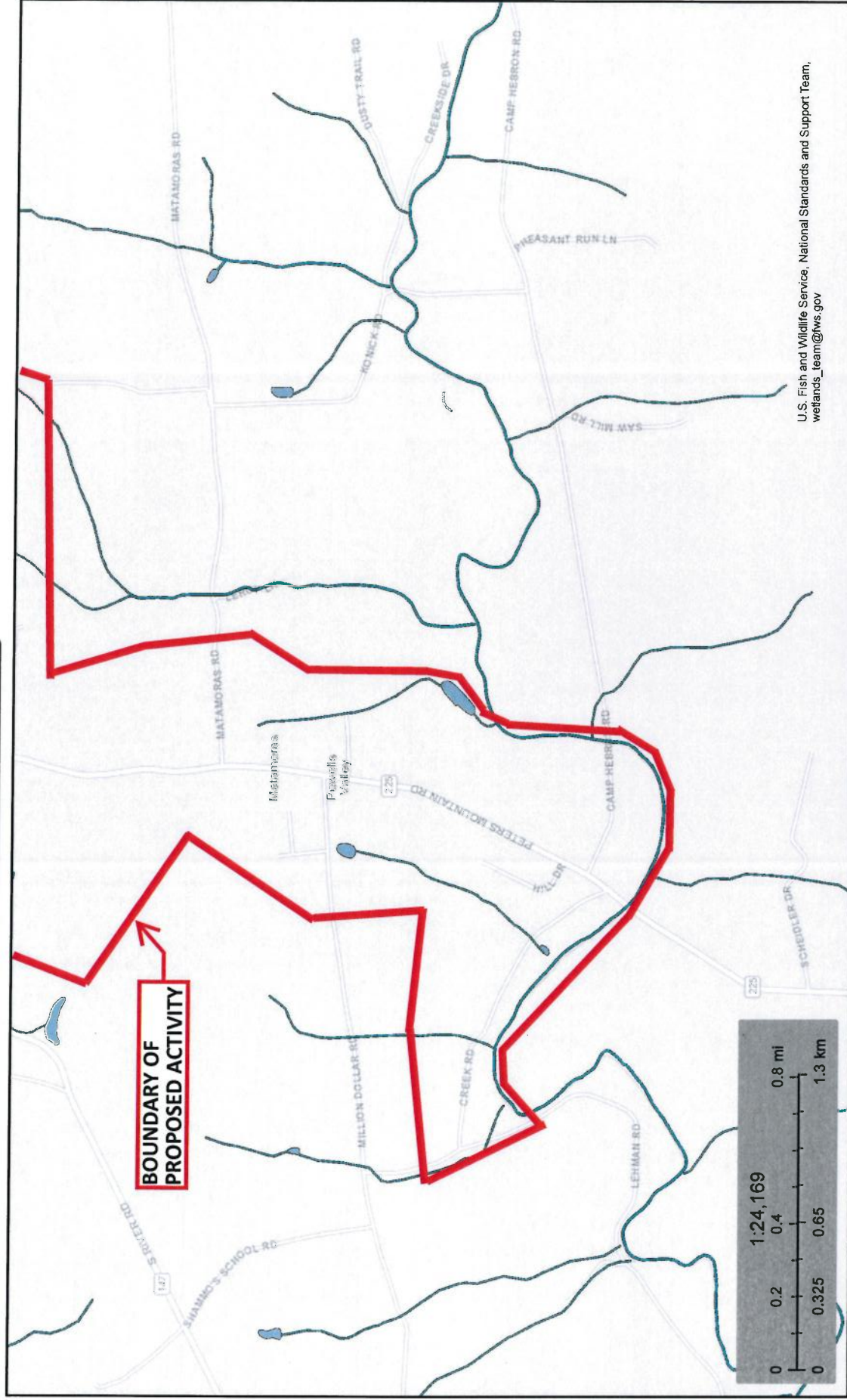

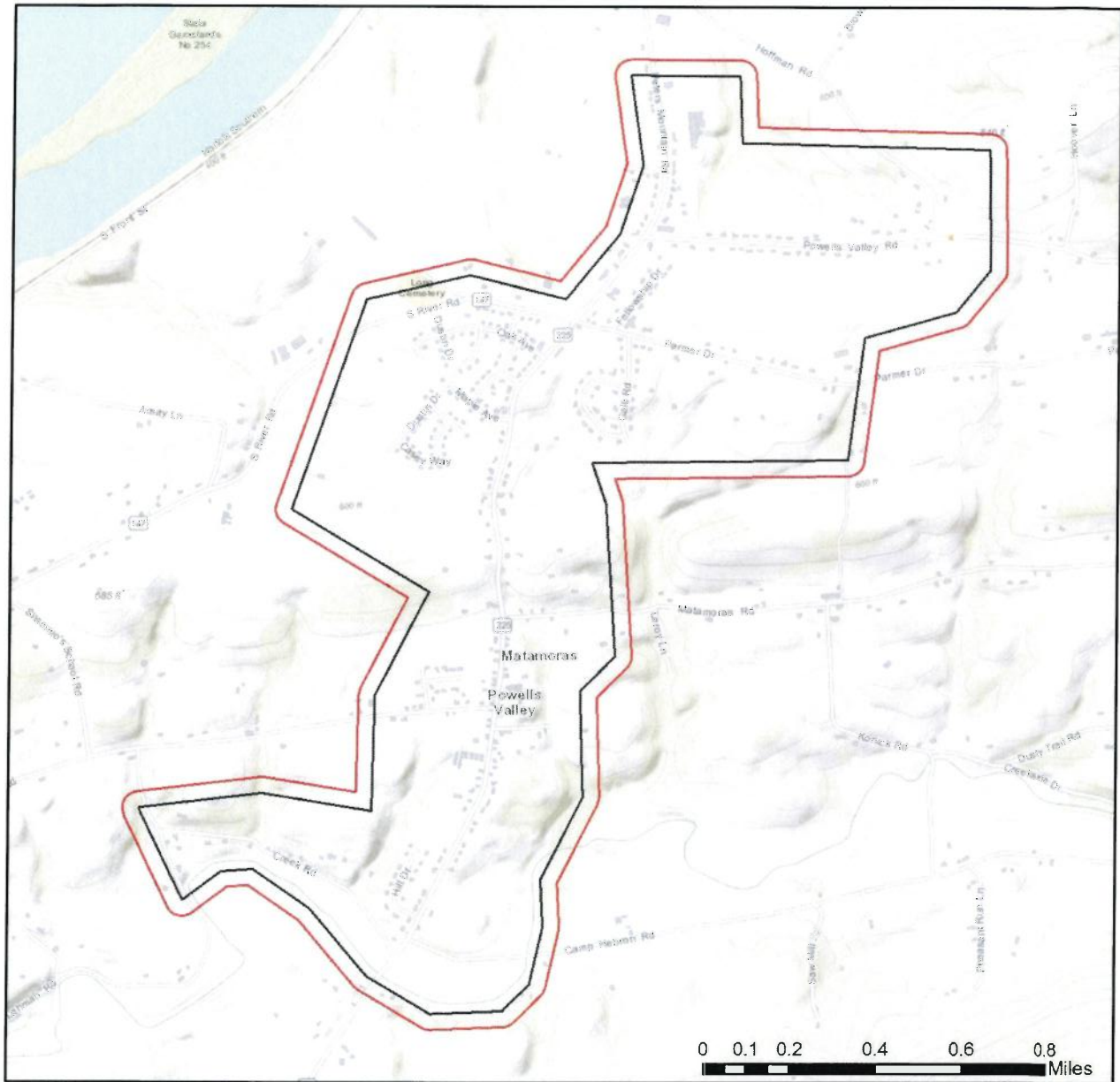

The Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) screened this project for potential impacts to species and resources of concern under PGC responsibility, which includes birds and mammals only.

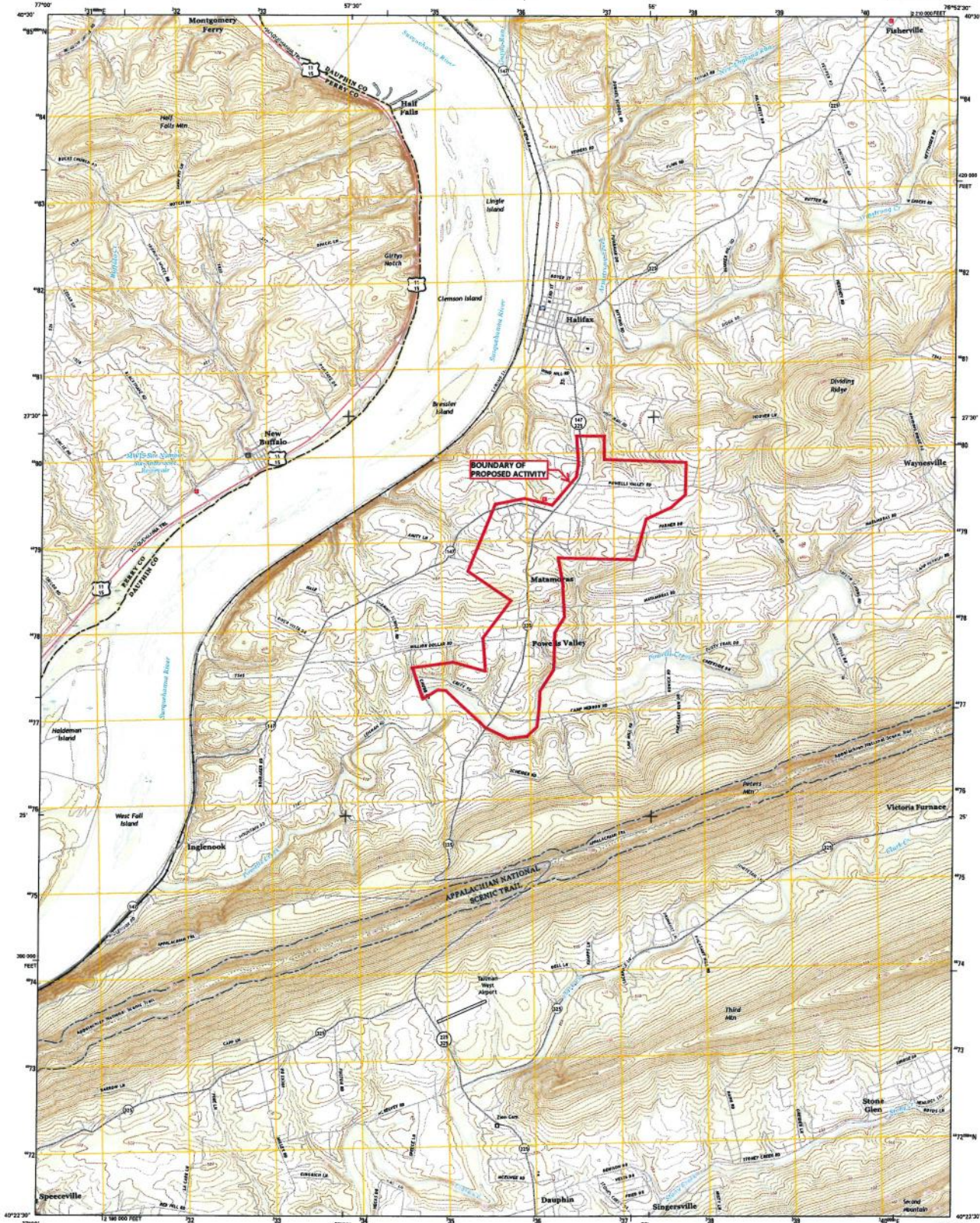
Project Narrative

Halifax Township is currently preparing an Act 537 Plan for the entire Township. There are three focus areas in the Township. The first focus area generally consists of the Matamoras, Route 147 & 225, and Triangle & Lenker Estates areas located within the Township. The second and third focus areas are the areas surrounding the community of Tourist Park and surrounding the Fetterhoff Church, both located within the Township.

At this time, the only sewer extension proposed to be included in the 0-5 year planning period for the Township will serve the Matamoras, Route 147 & 225, and Triangle & Lenker Estates areas. The proposed sewer extension is indicated on the attached map. Sewer like construction work in this area will likely involve the installation of a combination of gravity sewer main, low-pressure sewer main, pumping station and individual grinder pump units at select residences. The sewer installation will connect to the existing Halifax Area Water and Sewer Authority's collection system near the intersection of Routes 147 and 225 in Halifax Township.

Some of the structures in this area may be over 50 years old. However, none of the structures within the area will be impacted by this project, as all new facilities – with the exception of proposed pump stations – will be constructed below grade, mostly within Township and PennDOT rights-of-way.

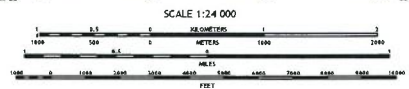
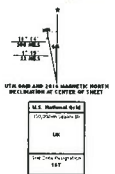

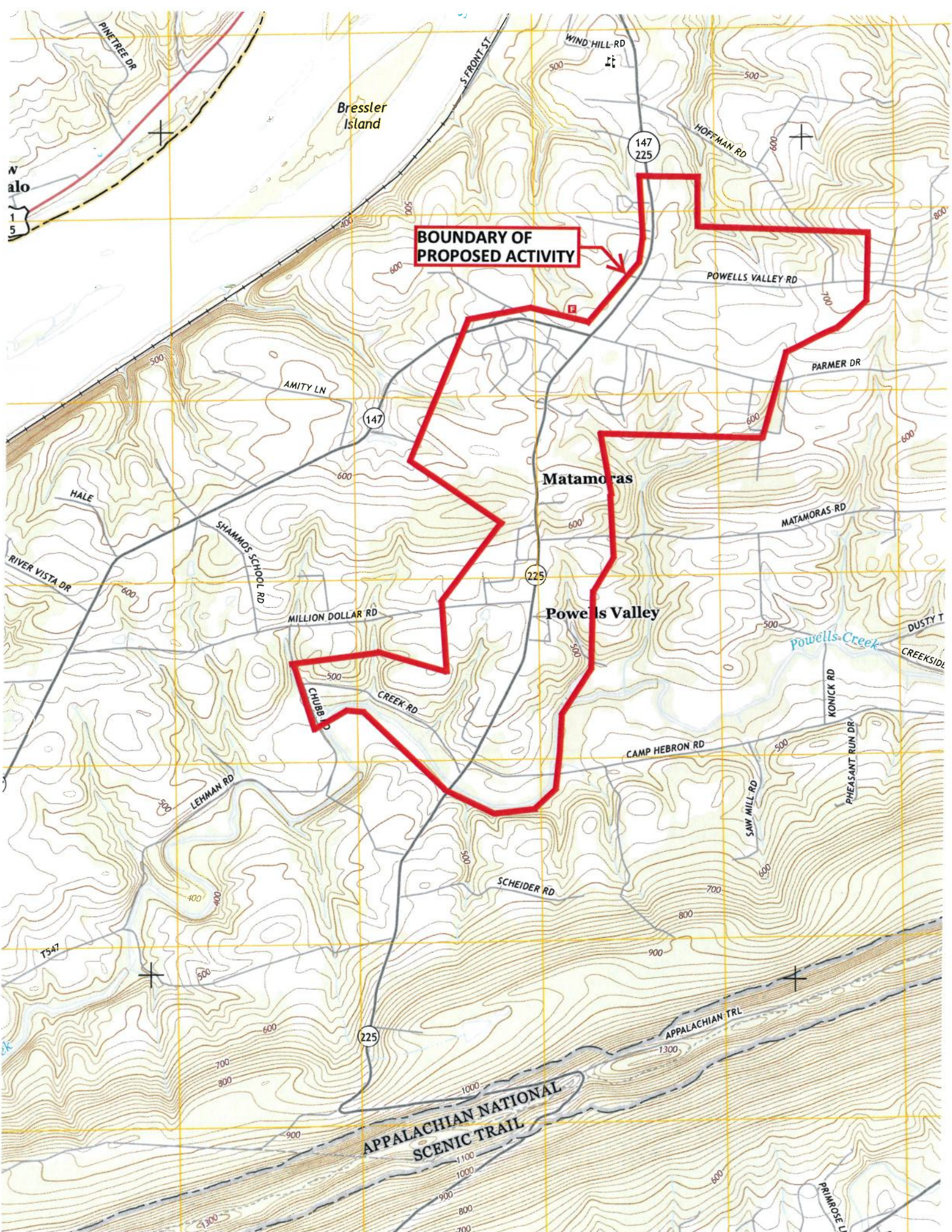

Thank you for submitting information concerning the above referenced project. The Pennsylvania State Historic Preservation Office (PA SHPO) reviews projects in accordance with state and federal laws. Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, and the implementing regulations (36 CFR Part 800) of the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, is the primary federal legislation. The Environmental Rights amendment, Article 1, Section 27 of the Pennsylvania Constitution and the Pennsylvania History Code, 37 Pa. Cons. Stat. Section 500 et seq. (1988) is the primary state legislation. These laws include consideration of the project's potential effects on both historic and archaeological resources.

Thank you for the plan of the preferred alternative and for providing additional information during our telephone conversation this afternoon. Our remarks are as follows:

Archaeological Resources


As the vast majority of the infrastructure locations will involve existing roads and streets or other previously developed locations, the only section that may be archaeologically sensitive is the vicinity of the proposed location of Pump Station 1, at the southern end of the project area. Based on an evaluation by our staff, including a review of the Statewide Pre-Contact Predictive Model, there is a high probability that National Register significant archaeological sites are present within this part of the project area. These resources could be adversely affected by project activities. Our review considers the locations of known archaeological resources, soil type, topographic setting, slope direction and distance to water, among other regionally specific predictive factors for archaeological site locations. It is our opinion that a Phase I archaeological survey should be conducted to locate potentially significant resources. Guidelines and instructions for conducting all phases of archaeological survey in Pennsylvania are available on our website [http://www.phmc.pa.gov/Preservation/About/Forms and Guidance/SHPO-Guidelines-Archaeological-Investigation.pdf](http://www.phmc.pa.gov/Preservation/About/Forms%20and%20Guidance/SHPO-Guidelines-Archaeological-Investigation.pdf).

Good afternoon Cory –

Mike Morris is no longer working for the planning section, so I wanted to get back to you with comments regarding the Halifax Township draft plan. I reviewed the plan along with Mark Sigouin, our hydrogeologist. We offer the following comments:

1. The maps submitted with the final adopted plan should be of large enough scale to be useful to the Department. All sample locations should be plotted and the map keyed to a table containing the results.
2. The nitrate map needs to show ¼ mile radii around all samples that exceed 5 mg/l nitrate-nitrogen. Areas with clusters of high nitrate wells should be noted. Preliminary hydrogeologic studies will be required in these areas.
3. The draft on-lot sewage management ordinance contains a five-year septic tank pumping schedule. DEP regulations (Chap. 71, Sec. 71.73) require on-lot systems be pumped every three years. The ordinance should reflect DEP regulations.
4. Four years to implement the sewage management ordinance appears a little excessive. The Department recommends the Township consider adopting the ordinance in 2019, and begin implementation by 2020.
5. The public sewer extension implementation schedule cannot be contingent on funding.

Dated October 30, 2018

General Comments:

1. Acknowledged and corrected. The enlarged map has been provided with the Final Plan
2. Acknowledged and updated. The radii were already shown, clusters have been noted and notation has been added to the Final Plan stating any proposed future development in these areas will require preliminary hydrogeologic studies (Page 3-16).
3. Acknowledged and updated. The Ordinance template has been changed to show an initial 3 year cycle instead of 5. As noted in the Plan, this is a template and the Final Ordinance developed by the Township will likely vary from the exact template provided.
4. Acknowledged and updated. In lieu of “years after the plan’s implementation,” hard deadlines have been set for the development and implementation of the ordinance. Finalization and adoption are proposed for years 2020-2021 and implementation is proposed for years 2021-2022. The Township is committed to meeting these deadlines. These changes are shown on implementation schedule located in the Executive Summary and Chapter 8.
5. No change in language required per follow-up email received from PA DEP on November 6, 2018.
